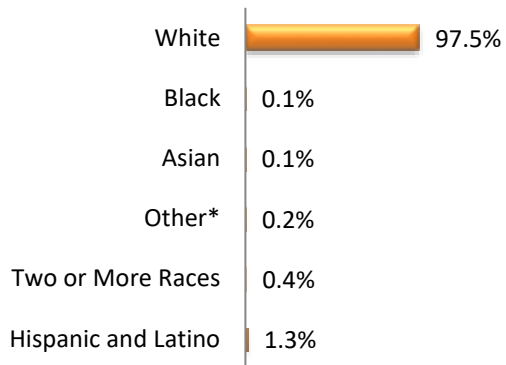

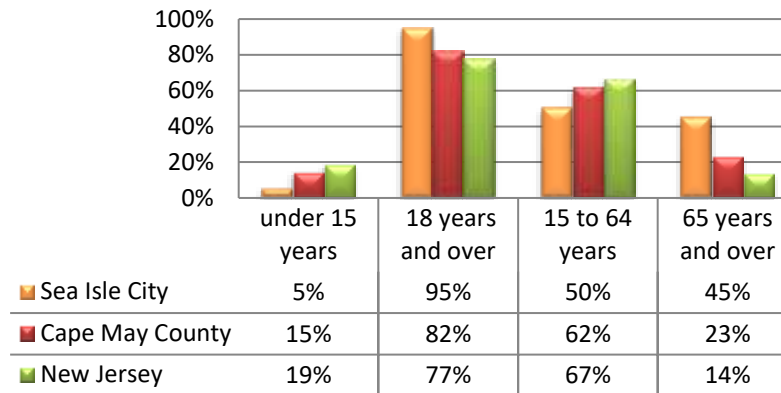

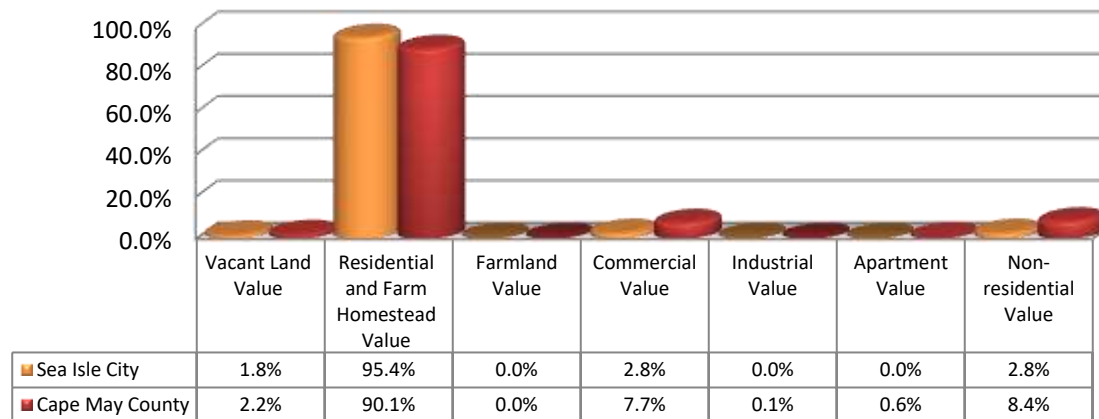

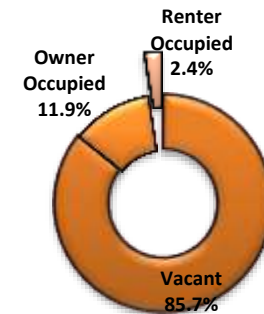

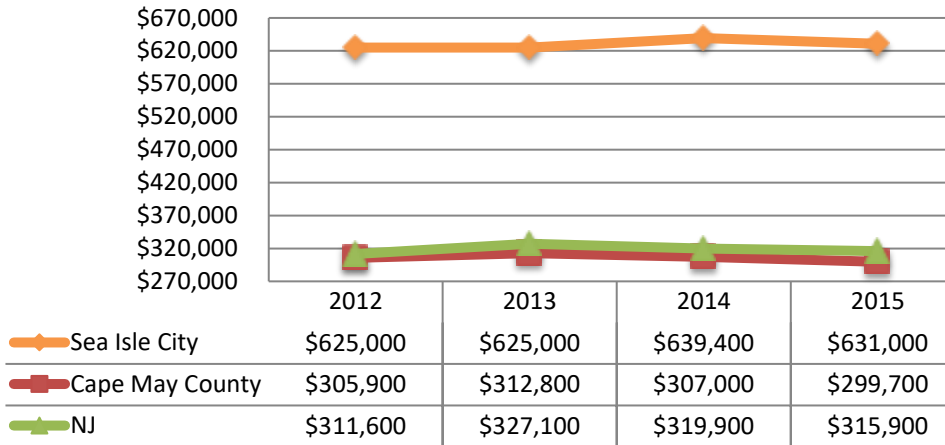

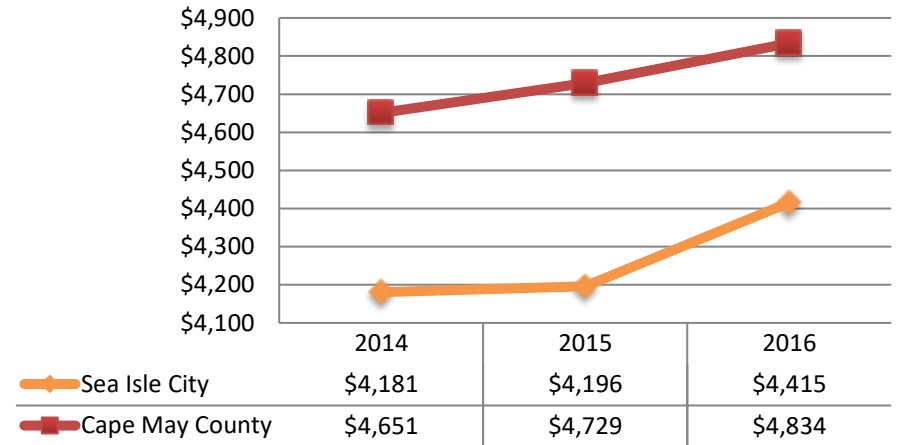

Average Property Tax

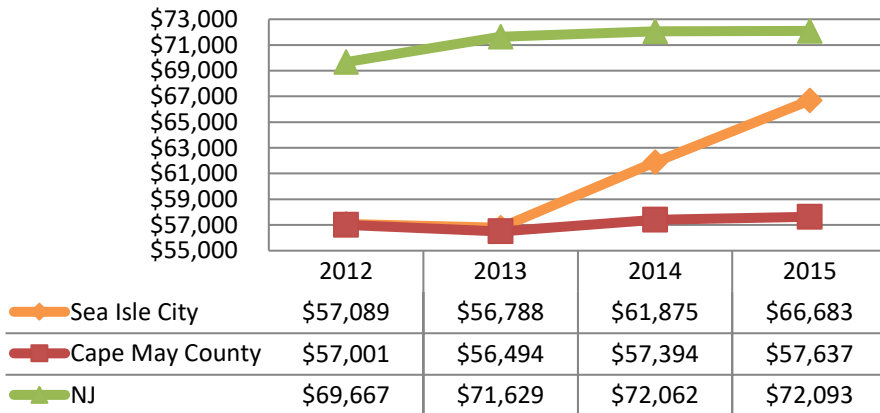

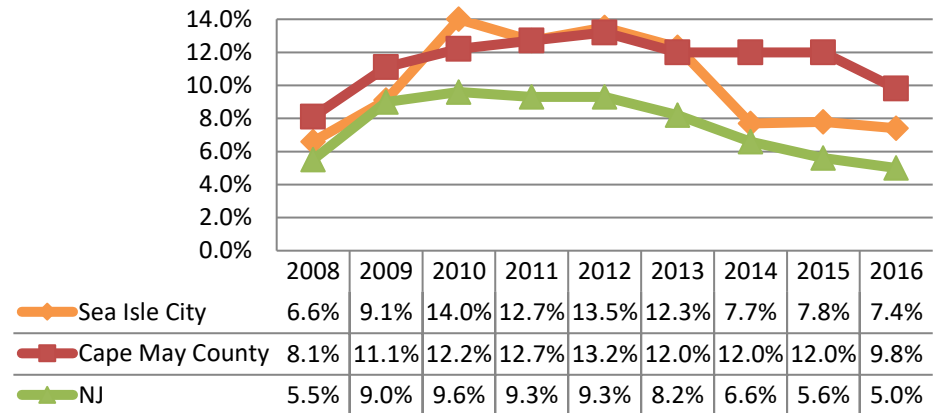

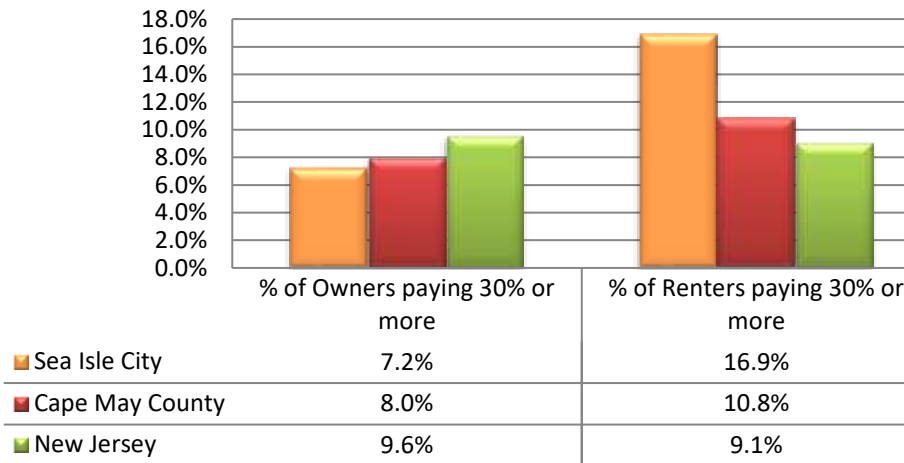
Unemployment Rate



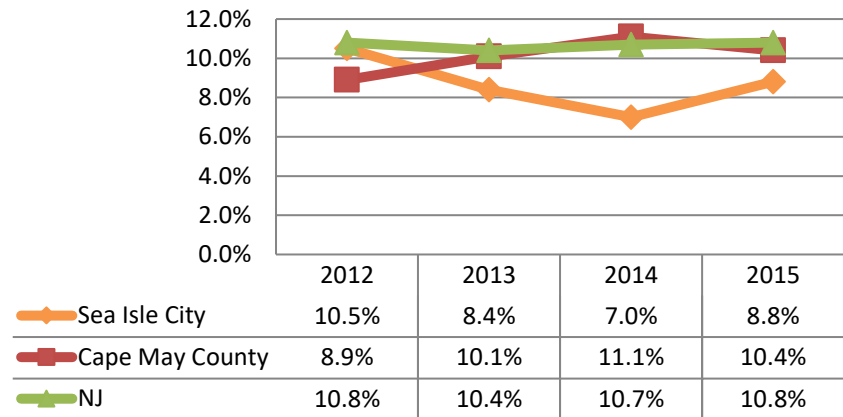

% of Home Owners and Renters Paying more than 30% of their Income on Housing



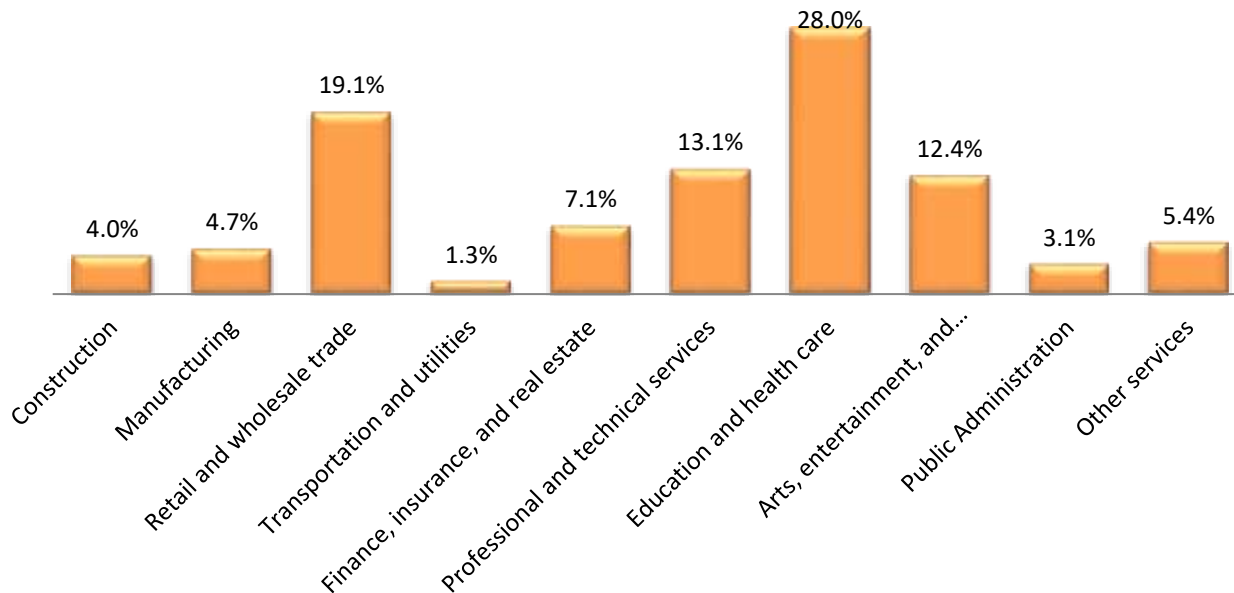
Poverty Rate



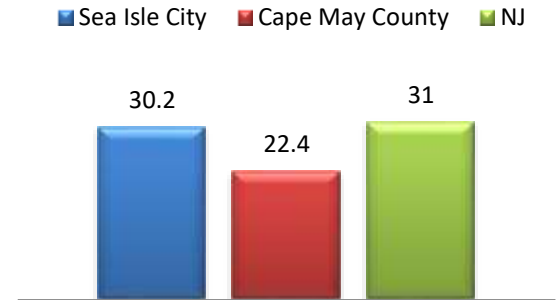

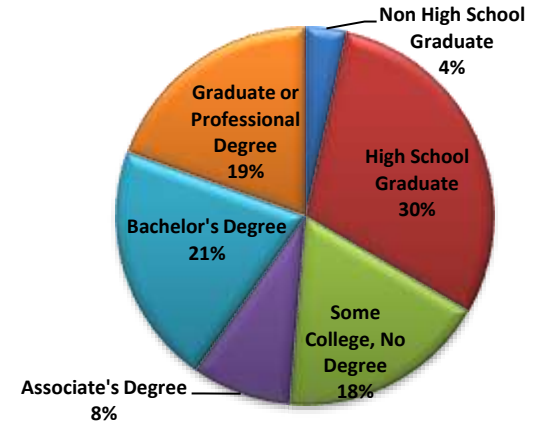
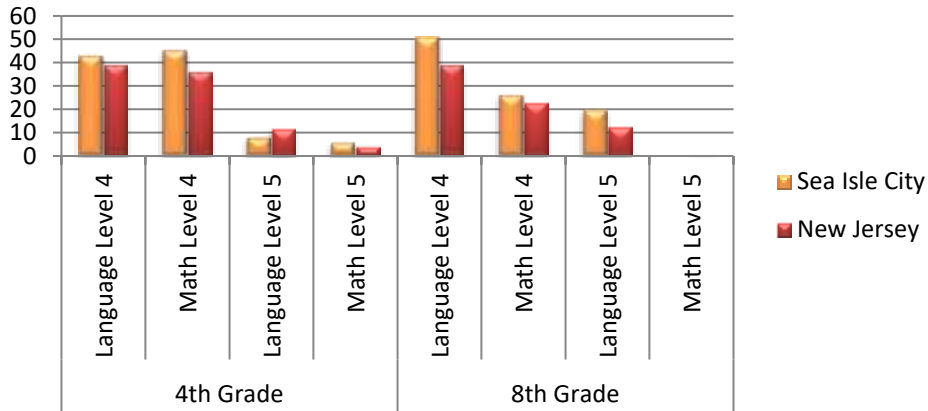

Highest Level of Education Attainment: People 25 years and over



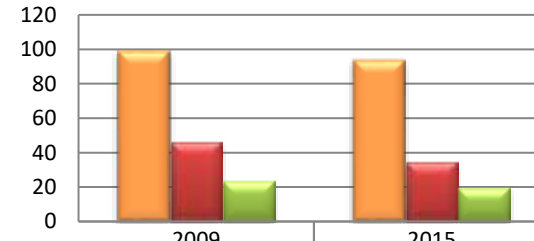
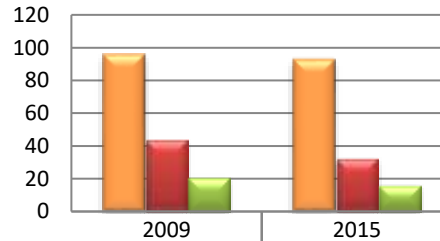
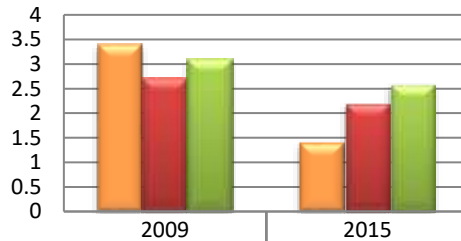
