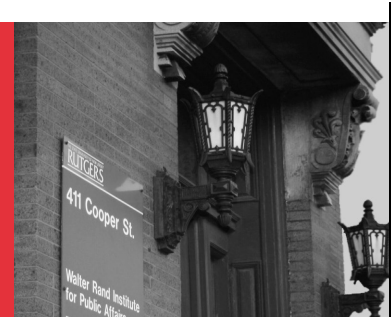

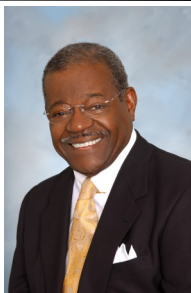

The Honorable Theodore Z. Davis, Justice Superior Court (Retired)

Theodore Z. Davis is retired from a long and distinguished legal career. He was appointed as interim COO of the City of Camden by Governor Jon Corzine in 2007 and served in that post until 2009. Prior to that, he served as a Superior Court Judge and Presiding Judge of the Chancery Division-General Equity. Prior to his time as a Superior Court Judge, Judge Davis served as Assistant City Attorney for the City of Camden, Assistant Prosecutor for Camden County, and Municipal Judge for the City of Camden. He retired from the bench in 2003, but continues serving the community.

He has served many institutions, including being on the Board of Trustees of Temple University and the Board of Temple Health System. Judge Davis has a B.A. degree in Accounting from Temple University's Business School and an LLB degree from the Temple University School of Law.

The Battleship New Jersey opened as a Museum and Memorial in October 2001.
